

LESSON 2, MARK CHAPTER 1:29-45

Please use the NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT) BIBLE for clarity.

Last week, we read in Mark that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and He brought *Good News*. Remember, the *Good News* is that Jesus came to die on the cross for our sins so if we believe in Him, we will live forever with Him in Heaven. We also met John the Baptist who came to get the people ready for Jesus. He was God's messenger. Then, we read about Jesus calling four fishermen to follow Him, and how they left their fishing boats to follow after Jesus.

Always pray and ask the Holy Spirit to be your teacher as you answer these questions. It is good to answer these questions with a parent and talk about the truths you discover together as you read God's Word.

It is important to memorize God's Word. Each week you have an opportunity to practice memorizing verses. Once the verses are in your head and your heart, God can help you to talk to your friends about the Bible and tell them about Jesus.


