Sin begins in our hearts and serves to defile or makes us unclean before God. Our thoughts should please God, but sometimes our thoughts are sinful. The Bible tells us in Philippians 4:8: "Fix your thoughts on what is true, and right and pure and lovely and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise."

When we have sinful thoughts, the Bible says we should go to God and confess those sinful thoughts. Jesus is faithful to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all sin.


What are you praying to Jesus for today? Will you continue to be persistent in prayer like this woman?
