

# CHAPTER 16 THE RESURRECTION

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the most significant truth of life. Without it, Paul says our faith is in vain. Because Jesus resurrected from the dead, we too, if we have put our faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross and have received forgiveness of sin, will experience the resurrected life. Jesus told Martha: "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" (John 11:25-26). In our final lesson of Mark's gospel, we will see proof of this truth and thus be motivated to proclaim: "He is risen!"

#### **MEMORY VERSE**

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned."

Mark 16:15-16

**Read Mark 16 prayerfully.** What does the resurrection of Jesus Christ prove to the whole world? To you personally?

6.	What instructions did the angel remind the women to do? Who did the angel name explicitly? As they went out quickly, describe how these women, who loved Jesus, were feeling (vv.7-8)? Where does Matthew tell us they were running to (Matt. 28:8)?
7.	How does John describe the sequence of events as Mary came to the tomb? What did she presume had happened to Jesus's body? Who did she run and tell? What was their reaction (John 20:1-4)?
8.	As the disciples reached the tomb, what did they find as they looked closer inside? What effect did that have on the disciple who arrived at the tomb first? What did they not understand from the Scriptures (John 20:5-10)?  DID YOU KNOW? The phrase "the eleven" in Mark 16:14 simply means "the apostles," because there were only ten of them together at that time, since Thomas was absent (John 20:19-25).


