THE PARABLES

Great multitudes were coming to Jesus. They were following Him for many reasons. Many wanted to just touch Jesus so their physical needs would be met and/or for healing. Jesus wanted them to "hear" as in to hear and understand His words. Jesus begins to teach the multitudes using *parables*.

"The purpose of a parable is not to veil truth-but to illustrate truth. In each of the parables of Jesus, truths that were being illustrated, truths that the people would not listen to with just a straight teaching method. And so the parable form of teaching was adopted, so that they might continue to hear truth. Only now in a more subtle way." *Pastor Chuck Smith*
